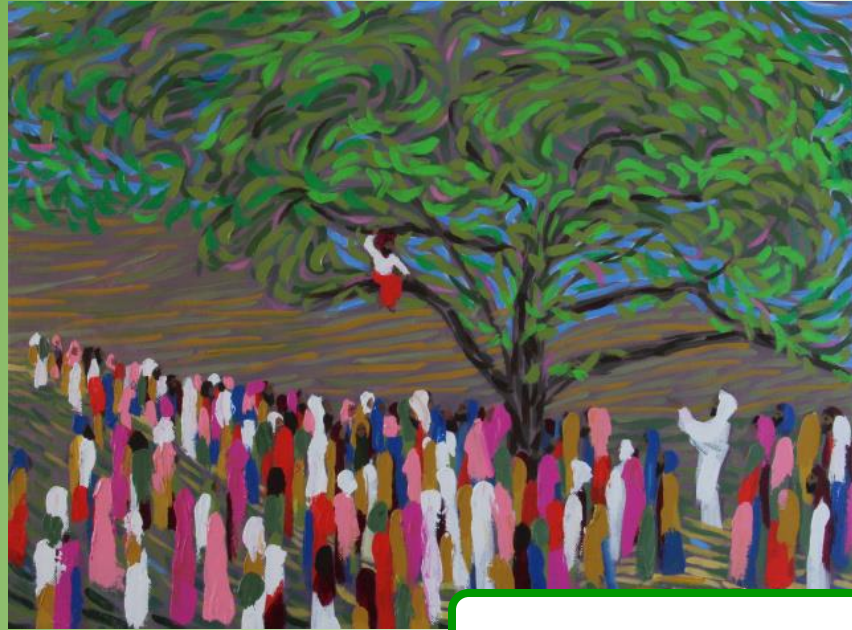


Being Sorry

Key Knowledge

Jesus helps us and forgives us
God helps us to be kind
We say sorry and forgive each other because we follow Jesus
We are happy when we love one another

Why is it important to be sorry?

Key Vocabulary

Choice – choosing between 2 or more things
Sign of Peace – blessing others with peace
Forgive – stop feeling angry towards someone
Sorry – when you wish you had not done something
Rule – the way things should be done

Luke 5: 27-31 – Levi the tax collector
Luke 19: 1-10 – Good News for Zacchaeus
John 13: 34-35 – A New Rule
